## CAMP DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES

**Carpool is open from 8:45-9:15 am and 1:45-2:15 pm every day. Please see below for assigned staggered times and directions, designed for everyone's health and safety.**

### STAGGARED TIMES AND DIRECTIONS

As you enter the JCC parking lot area, please drive straight towards the main building, turn left before the front circle, and follow the road around to the signs for your child's program.

**PRESCHOOL** (ages 3 & 4) cars will turn left at the front circle and then turn right towards the back of the building. (8:45 - 9:00 am/1:45 - 2:00 pm)

**KINDERGARTEN** 2nd grade and Tikvah (special needs) cars will turn left before the front circle, go to the end of the road and turn left, and then follow signs to make a left into the third parking lot. (9:00 - 9:15 am/1:45 - 2:00 pm)

**3RD-6TH GRADE & SPECIALTY CAMP** Cars will turn left before the front circle, go to the end of the road and turn left, and then follow signs to make a left into the second parking lot. (8:45 - 9:00 am/2:00 - 2:15 pm)

### PLEASE NOTE

If you are dropping off campers of different ages, please drop off your preschool camper first and then your older camper. If you have more than one camper between Kindergarten and 6th Grade you will need to drop off each child individually. Our Health Check will be done once for all campers in the car at your first drop off point. You will receive a ticket to submit at drop off for each additional child.

When coming into camp for carpool pick-up, you always need to display your carpool card on the front windshield on the driver's side. For security reasons, no child will be allowed to be picked up without a carpool card that gives authorization.

For everyone's safety, there is NO PASSING of other cars permitted once you are on the carpool line. Please wait until the car in front of you moves and remain in a single line. Please be reminded that we are not allowed by state law to help you buckle your child for the way home.

All parents and campers must wear a mask at all times during drop-off and pick-up. Parents may not leave their car except to buckle a camper in at the end of the day, and only after the counselor has completely stepped away from the car.

Please follow our staff's directions and signage. We expect the first few days of carpool to take a little longer as parents are adjusting to a new routine. We thank you in advance for your patience and understanding in working together to get everyone home safely.
